- \* If Screen 5 appears, execute "\EnvMEL\Setup.exe" in the CD-ROM.

After completion of the "Environment of MELSOFT" installation, Screen 6 may be displayed. Click on "This program installed correctly", and close the screen.

Do not select "Reinstall using recommended settings" because selecting it will install improper modules.
